Pursuant to the Directorate of Food Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Assam, Guwahati's W. T. Message No. DS. 68/2014/4 dated 20/03/2014 regarding monthly allocation of Rice for the BPL beneficiaries under TPDS scheme for the month of **April /2014** and in exercise of the powers conferred by clause- read with clause-28(b) of the Assam Public Distribution of the Articles Order, 1982 and the provisions of the Public Distribution System (control) Order, 2001, I Dr. J. Balaji IAS, Deputy Commissioner and Licensing Authority, Kamrup, Amingaon do hereby make the allocation of **20481.98** quintals out of the Directorate's total allocation of **20493.54** quintals of such rice with the break up of **20001.62** quintals per month amongst 60710 numbers of BPL beneficiary families @ **32.946** kilograms per family per month for the GPSS/WCCS Limited Under Kamrup Sadar Sub-Division and **480.36** quintals per month for M/S Baghmara Char GPSS Limited under Barpeta District for the afore stated month respectively. The nominee GPSS/WCCS Limited are directed to deposit the Government fixed value of allotted Rice (BPL Category) to the F.C.I., Guwahati within **15/04/2014** for the month of **April /2014** quotas and arrange lifting of said rice there from within **20/04/2014**, without fail. They are also directed to submit the arrival report against lifting of BPL rice so allotted and issue the same to the appointed retailers (i. e Agents/FPS dealers) attached with them for ultimate distribution amongst Family Identity Card holders under P.D.S. at a quantum of **32.946** kgs per family per month each at the Govt. fixed rate.
