ORDER

Dated Amingaon, the 12th January'2012

Whereas, it has been revealed from the allocation and lifting report of Levy Sugar that due to non availability of Levy Sugar with the Food Corporation of India, the nominee GPSS/WCCS Limited of Kamrup Sadar Sub-Division could not lift cent percent allotted quantity of Levy Sugar for the month of November'2011 and December'2011 quotas including the month of January'2012 till date. The Central Government vide letter no.5-5(ASSAM) 2007-SC-II/85 dated 08.12.2011 read with Directorate's of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Assam, Guwahati's W. T. Message No.DS.202/2005/118 dated 16.12.2011.extension of validity period of depositing value and delivery of Levy Sugar remain un-lifted against the month of September, October and November'2011 up to 31.01.2012.

And whereas, the Principal Secretary to the Government of Assam, Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Department, Dispur has categorically instructed that the un-lifted quantity of levy sugar of aforesaid months should be lifted immediately from Food Corporation of India and than distribution of same must be made at a time to avoid siphoning of PDS sugar of previous month. Accordingly, the GPSS/WCCS wise quantity of levy sugar due per head in the month of January'2012 has been worked out below on the basis of allocation and lifting reports received in this regard.

Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause-26 read with clause-28(b) of the Assam Public Distribution of Articles Order, 1982 read with clause-6(4) of

the Public Distribution System (Control) Order, 2001, I Shri S. K. Roy, ACS Deputy Commissioner and Licensing Authority, Kamrup do hereby instruct the Area Manager, FCI, Guwahati District, Guwahati to release the cent percent allocated quantity of the levy sugar of the aforesaid months to the nominee GPSS/WCCS Limited of Kamrup Sadar Sub-Division subject to realization of its value. The nominee GPSS/WCCS Limited, in turn, must lift the backlog quantity of levy sugar including January'2012 quota immediately and than shall distribute the levy sugar per head in the month of January'2012 as per quantity shown in column-9 above without fail.

Furthermore, henceforth, All Inspectors of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs of Kamrup are hereby directed to make Fair Price Shop (i.e. Agents) wise sub- allocation of levy sugar, rice (all categories), wheat products (whole meal atta & Bran) including Kerosene Oil from their own as per 2011 census (Provisional) population/families and instruct the Presidents/Secretaries of the GPSS/WCCS of their respective areas of jurisdiction to release the same to their licensee F. P. Shop dealer at fixed price for ultimate distribution amongst FIC holders. They must submit agent wise sub-allocation order copies of each aforesaid articles of each GPSS/WCCS of their respective areas of Jurisdiction to the undersigned.

Any deviation/non-compliance of this order shall be dealt with under section-7 (1) (a) of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (Act 10 of 1955)
