(1)** contained in the minutes of the meeting held on 28.11.2011 under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Minister, Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Assam as communicated vide Government memo no. FSA.236/2005/Pt./79 dated 23.12.2011, inter-alia in the matter of disposal of un-lifted stock of wheat products lying in form of whole wheat (APL) since December'2010 with the Roller Flour Mills of Kamrup, I Shri S.K.Roy, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Kamrup Amingaon in exercise of the powers conferred by clause-26 read with clause-28 (b) of the Assam Public Distribution of Articles Order, 1982, do hereby make the re-allocation of un-lifted stock of **29556.00 quintals of whole meal atta ( ex-mill price of whole meal atta is Rs.977.00 per quintal ) for the period from January/Feb./March/April/2012 out of quota of accumulated balance stock of Special Additional Adhoc quotas of whole wheat' lying as a whole wheat with the under mentioned Roller Flour Mills for the period from June/July/2010 to March./2012**, for its distribution through PDS/TPDS **per APL family per month (i.e. January/12 to April/12 only** on production of Family Identity Cards and payment prices already fixed in this regard.

However the quantum of W/atta varies GPSS wise due to the difference of stock of W/atta at different R. F. Mills and also that the entire stock of W/atta is to be disposed of immediately.


